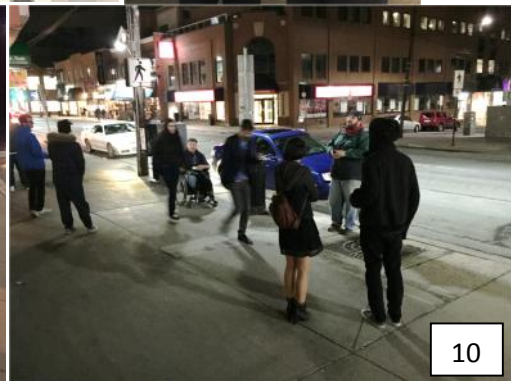
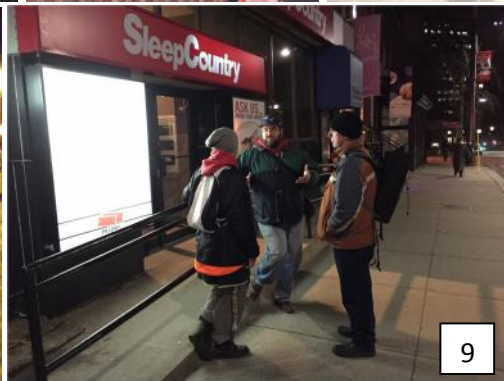
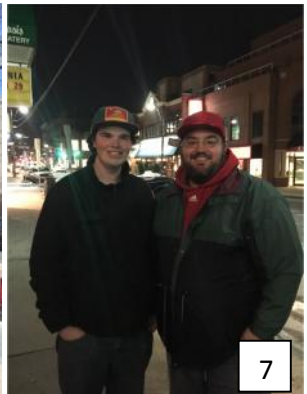


What's Happening with the Hubicks?
